Really, they are our family in this country because they did a very difficult job to make everything easy for us. They helped us in every way-finding the school for our children, in fact the head teachers came to welcome us the first day we arrived! Our new friends helped us to find our way, a doctor who spoke Arabic, a dentist, taking us to the Job Centre. We had a wonderful interpreter who helped so much."
